

The **Visix** digital signage hardware offering gets a **Nano** player-- an ultra-small form factor appliance purpose-built to provide reliable 1080p playback for digital signs, measuring just 17 centimetres square.

"This is our smallest player yet, and it can fit anywhere," the company claims. "Our customers are looking for compact, economical solutions for their signage installations. This is a perfect player for less video-intensive applications, that still demand highly reliable performance."

The Nano player includes 64GB eMMC storage, 4GB LPDDR4 memory and support for both wired and wireless networking. Powering it is an Intel Apollo Lake Celeron N3350 processor, and it comes with a Kensington security port.
